

2.8.1 ADMISSION AND APPEALS PROCEDURE 11-16

As a secondary school serving both urban and rural areas, following the allocation of places to pupils who have a statement of special educational needs which names the school as appropriate provision, when there are more applications for places than there are places available, priority will be given in the following order:	
i.	Children in public care (looked after children)
ii.	Pupils who live in the designated villages i.e. Bozeat, Brafield-on-the-Green, Castle Ashby, Chadstone, Cogenhoe, Denton, Easton Maudit, Great Houghton, Grendon, Irchester, Little Houghton, Strixton, Wollaston, Yardley Hastings, Whiston.
iii.	Pupils who will have an older brother or sister continuing at Wollaston School .
iv.	Pupils attending Wollaston School's designated contributory Primary Schools ie Bozeat, Cogenhoe, Denton, Grendon, Irchester, Little Houghton, Wollaston, Yardley Hastings on 1st November and continuing in attendance until the formal offer of places is made.
v.	Pupils who live in Wellingborough and the designated surrounding villages and contributory parishes for Wellingborough as detailed in this booklet
vi.	Other pupils
